<u>Attainment - Children reaching Age Related Expectations</u>

The Department for Education uses as a benchmark, the percentage of pupils attaining Age Related Expectations (ARE) or more by the end of Year 6 in reading, writing and maths (ie all three).

In 2016, 83% of our pupils reached Age Related Expectations in all three subjects. (National 53%)

It's also useful to think about the breakdown between the core subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths (also included is the assessment of Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling).
