Key Stage Two SATs results 2019



Attainment - Children reaching Age Related Expectations

The Department for Education uses as a benchmark, the percentage of pupils attaining Age Related Expectations (ARE) or more by the end of Year 6 in reading, writing and maths (ie all three).

In 2019, 81% of our pupils reached Age Related Expectations in all three subjects. (National 65%)

It's also useful to think about the breakdown between the core subjects of Reading, Writing and Maths (also included is the assessment of Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling).

KS2 Progress
